Man kills and buries aunt under dry concrete

BEIRUT: A man killed his aunt and buried her under dry concrete in the town of Bhamdoun in Mount Lebanon after having sold her apartment in the Beirut suburb of Jnah in exchange for \$20,000, the National News Agency reported Sunday. According to the NNA, police found the body of Fatima Ayyoub, 76, buried under dry concrete in the town of Bhamdoun in the district of Aley. Ayyoub, who went missing from her apartment in Jnah on Feb. 4, 2012 was killed by her nephew, Fadi Ayyoub, and his accomplice, Syrian national, Mabrouk Iyada. The police arrested Ayyoub and Iyada who both confessed to strangling the aunt and transferring her body in a fridge to Bhamdoun where they buried her under dry concrete. Ayyoub had sold his aunt's apartment for \$20,000 and killed her after the buyer asked for the papers needed to register the apartment. The police cracked open the concrete and extracted the body which was transferred to the Public Hospital.
