

Alleged Israeli collaborator's friends condemn his arrest

Friends of Sheikh Hassan Msheimesh issued a statement on Friday questioning "the hasty arrest" of Msheimesh, who was charged for collaborating with Israel.

The signatories accused Hezbollah of pressuring Msheimesh's family, adding that they will consider him a "prisoner of conscience" until they receive irrefutable proof of the Sheikh's guilt.

On Wednesday, Government Commissioner to the Military Court Judge Saqr Saqr charged Msheimesh and Samer Ali Hajj Hassan with collaborating with Israel and providing information on Hezbollah in exchange for money.
