Court charges 2 men for collaborating with Israel

BEIRUT: Two Lebanese men, including an imam, were charged Wednesday by the Military Tribunal for collaborating with Israel.

Sheikh Hasan Mshaimesh and Samer Ali Hajj were charged for working with Israel and providing the Jewish state with information on Hezbollah in return for money.

Mshaimesh is an imam in the Nabatieh village of Kfar Sir. Judge Saqr Saqr referred the two men to the military magistrate. They face the death penalty if convicted.
